Informational Meeting - April 29, 2019 - 6:00 p.m. - Town Hall 1 2 PRESENT: Chair Jim Erdman, Supervisor Matt Merten, Supervisor Bill 3 4 Demler, Treasurer Laura Hunt, Clerk Jeannette Merten, town attorney John 5 St. Peter, General Engineering Project Engineer Jerry Foellmi, and Grant & 6 Funding Coordinator Elizabeth Foellmi and audience of 11. 7 8 Chair Erdman called meeting to order at 6:10 p.m. 9 10 General Engineering Project Engineer Jerry Foellmi provided a power point 11 presentation and a copy of the Feasibility Study draft. 12 13 It covered historical and political background discovering that in 1935 plans show residences along Butler Avenue connected to sewer and water. By 14 15 1941, the Butler Avenue area is well developed. Therefore, the utilities are 16 determined to be approximately 80-years old. 17 The Winnebago Area includes 21 single family homes, 1 post office, 2 18 19 apartment complexes with approximately 103 residents. 20 21 The scope of work of the feasibility study is to determine the most 22 acceptable and cost-effective way for residents of the Winnebago area to 23 continue to receive water and sewer services and what their options are. 24 25 The study covers land values, taxes, and assessments comparisons. 26 It also covered the existing water and wastewater systems, what the 27 28 proposed water and wastewater replacement may include. 29 30 Options, in the end, providing pros and cons to each with estimates are: Do nothing 31 Annexation 32 33 Create a town utility Connect to existing sanitary district 34 35 Activate existing sanitary district Create new sanitary district 36 37 Private wells and holdings tanks 38 According to DOA and DHS, it has been indicated that additional CDBG funds 39 **40** are available and allowed if required allowing flexibility to the already 41 committed 1-million dollars to complete the project.

The residents in attendance are in favor of creating a new sanitary district. 43 None opposed. Some residents could not attend this meeting. The group 44 keeps in contact with their own method. Persons who have attended prior 45 meetings have kept the others informed. Persons in attendance said they **46** are not aware of any persons in this area who would object to the creation of 47 a new sanitary district based on the developments through this process and **48** the facts presented. The group agreed that there would be opposition to the 49 50 annexation route. 51 52 In summary, the consensus from area residents/property owners is to proceed with the detachment from Town of Oshkosh Sanitary District and to 53 54 create the Winnebago Sanitary District. 55 56 Motion made by Erdman, Demler seconded, to adjourn.
